

esus' conception and birth were special and miraculous events that took place by the power of the Holy Spirit.

A young woman, Mary, was chosen by God from all women to be the mother of God's Son, Jesus. When the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary and asked her to be the mother of God's Son, she immediately answered "yes" without hesitation or knowing God's plan (Luke 1:38). Her faithfulness and trust in God was immediate and without question. She never doubted. Instead, she joyfully proclaimed that she was the servant of the Lord who was fully accepting of God's will.

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, Mary, a virgin, conceived and gave birth to God's Son, Jesus. Today, Mary is a model for each of us as a person of faith who willingly accepted God's call and said "yes" to God.
