Using the Study Guide

As you use this study guide, you will find each lesson follows a pattern.

The **Introduction** sets the stage to draw your group into the lesson.

The Lesson Theme begins with a Bible verse drawn from the text you will study together. This verse highlights God's grace revealed by the angel(s). Then the two statements that follow show how God acts and angels serve.

Getting Started provides questions to spark thought and discussion. Involve everyone in sharing thoughts and answers to the questions.

Into the Word leads your group into the Scriptures. The text is printed for you in this study guide. Sometimes you will be asked to look at additional texts. It will be helpful to read ahead of class time the chapters listed at the end of some sessions. Discussion questions help you step into the story.

Sing of God's Grace gives your group the opportunity to sing with the angels. Singing praises was one way the people in these accounts expressed their joy and thanks for God's action on their behalf. As you join in singing, remember your praise for God is more important than musical ability!

Something to Think About is designed to help you apply each lesson to yourself personally. Don't skip this! As the level of trust deepens in your group, you will find it rewarding to share your thoughts, feelings and experiences.

The Closing Prayer summarizes the main truths in each lesson and may be prayed aloud together. Additional prayers for one another and for loved ones may follow to close the session.

Be sure of this: God will bless your time with him in his Word!

Session One

The Angel in the Garden: Adam and Eve

Introduction

The Advent and Christmas seasons are aflutter with angels. They appear everywhere! Angels on cards ... in centerpieces ... on jewelry... on Christmas treetops ... in children's pageants ... even on cookie trays. We will sing of angels in carols and hymns. But best of all, during Advent and Christmas we will hear the story of angels in readings from holy Scripture. Angels! You can't miss them! But what do we know about angels? What is their role? How does God use them to bless his people and reveal his love?

Angels appear in the four Advent lessons in this study booklet. In this first lesson we will get acquainted with real angels. We will discover the role God's angels played in revealing God's love for people.
