**1st Sunday in Lent 21**

Teach me your paths, O Lord, and lead me in your truth.  
Psalm 25: 4-5

**22**

Talk about the ways you learn God's truths. Reading the Bible is an important way.

Hearing God's Word in worship each week is another way.

Ask Mom or Dad about all the parts of the worship service.

Share your learning with each other during family devotions.

**2nd Sunday in Lent**

Take up your cross and follow me.  
Mark 8:34

**March 1st**

If we follow Jesus, what does that "look" like?

**2**

Following Jesus means believing Jesus died for you, forgives you, cares for you and will some day give you a home in heaven. It also means telling someone else about Jesus!

**3**

Following Jesus means caring for others. Do you know a lonely older person who might like to share her photograph album? Ask questions. Listen!

**4**

Decorate a terra cotta pot with acrylic paints in any design you wish. Then plant some flower seeds and remember to water. Can you think how a seed that "dies" in the ground and then sprouts and blooms os like Jesus' resurrection?

**5**

Following Jesus also means praying daily. Did you know you can talk to God about anything? Ask for help to follow faithfully!

Following Jesus also means saying you're sorry when you've hurt someone and asking Jesus to forgive you.

**3rd Sunday in Lent**

Stop making my Father's house a market place!  
John 2:16

**8**

During Lent we usually have special ways of giving—collecting clothes for homeless people, making a casserole for someone who is sick, collecting money for a special project to help hurting people. Did you know you can help children in Africa who suffer from malaria? Your money can buy mosquito nets that help keep children healthy.

**10**

If you had \$10 to help someone, how would you use it? Start saving!

**11**

Here's a new meal-time prayer to learn.

For food and all your gifts of love, we give you thanks and praise. Look down, O Father, from above and bless us all our days.

Make a list of the things God gives us to do outside:

Spring has sprung! 20

God sends rain to bless us. Look outside to see who else likes rain!

**14**

**4th Sunday in Lent**

God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him will have everlasting life.  
John 3:16

**15**

A cross is the symbol of Jesus' love for us. Make a mosaic cross with old magazines, a glue stick and black construction paper. Glue small pieces cut from colorful magazine pages onto a black background and hang it in a good spot.

**16**

This is how to say "I love you" in sign language. Share God's love with someone today.

**17**

St. Patrick taught us that a shamrock with three leaves is like the Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Three-in-one and one-in-three.

**18**

The words from John 3:16 are called the Gospel in a "nutshell." Memorize it today!

**19**

Think of a way to share God's love day. Be a friend.

St. Paul tells us "how really wonderful it is that your faith is growing along with your love for each other!"  
2 Thessalonians 1:3  
Sounds like springtime flowers!
