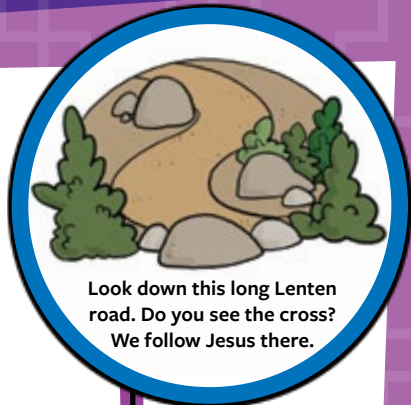


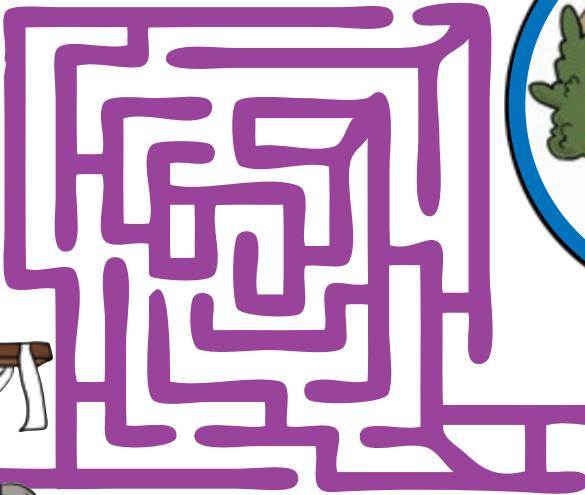


What Do I See at Calvary?

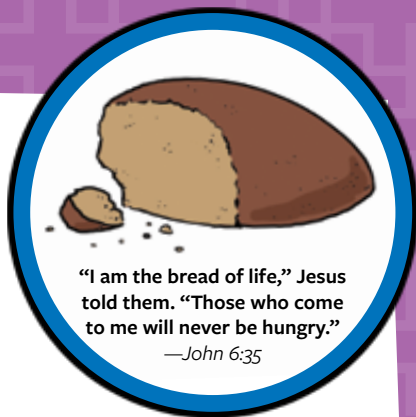
