Here is an interesting and family-friendly way to journey through the days of Lent on the way to Good Friday and Easter. Five trivia questions on various topics related to the life, suffering, death and resurrection of Christ appear on each card. Families can wonder about what the answers might be and check to see if their answers are right

as a quick devotion on the go. Tear off pages whenever you want throughout Lent. Read the questions on the front and turn the card over to uncover the answers. Quiz one another about the “Where and When” of the last days of Christ on earth. Find out about the “Lent Objects” associated with the season. Discover the “People” who were part of the Passion story of Christ. Learn the famous “Quotes” people said during Holy Week. Determine challenging “True or False” statements about the story of Jesus.

When & Where: How long was Jesus in the wilderness?

Lent Objects: What is placed on our foreheads the first day of Lent?

People: What disciples were called the Sons of Thunder?

Quotes: Who said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world"?

True or False: Jesus had 13 disciples.

W&W: Jesus was in the wilderness for 40 days (Mark 1:13), which is the number of days Lent lasts (excluding Sundays).

LO: A cross of ashes is placed on the foreheads of parishioners on Ash Wednesday as a reminder that “You are dust, and to dust you shall return” (Genesis 3:19).

Pe: The brothers James and John were called the Sons of Thunder, perhaps because they were aggressive and assertive and not afraid of confrontation (Mark 3:17).

Qu: John the Baptist (John 1:29)

ToF: False. Jesus had 12 disciples (Matthew 10:1).

When & Where: Where was Jesus arrested?

Lent Objects: How many silver coins were paid to Jesus' betrayer?

People: Who betrayed Jesus?

Quotes: Who said, "Would you betray the Son of Man with a kiss?"

True or False: Satan tempted Jesus three times in the wilderness.

W&W: Jesus was arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14:32, 46).

LO: 30 silver coins (Matthew 26:15)

Pe: Judas Iscariot (Matthew 26:25)

Qu: Jesus (Luke 22:48)

ToF: True. (Matthew 4:1-11)

When & Where: What did Jesus and the disciples do just before they went to the Mount of Olives?

Lent Objects: What did the crowd arresting Jesus carry with them?

People: Who cut off the high priest's servant's ear?

Quotes: Who said, "Not my will, but thine be done"?

True or False: The disciples ran away when Jesus was arrested.

W&W: The disciples sang a hymn just before they went to the Mount of Olives (Matthew 26:30).

LO: Swords and clubs (Matthew 26:47)

Pe: Simon Peter (John 18:10)

Qu: Jesus (Matthew 26:39)

ToF: True. (Matthew 26:56)

When & Where: Who stood in the courtyard when Jesus was on trial?

Lent Objects: What kept people warm as they waited for a verdict?

People: Who tore his robes in anger over Jesus' answer to him?

Quotes: Who said, "This man was also with him"?

True or False: Blasphemy means to praise God.
